Khabibullo Nosirov, SPACECOM project coordinator in Uzbekistan answered the question about the Commission's response on the project report and presented the following information to the participants: “Shortly after the report was sent, I received a question from the Commission about the reasons for changing bank details. I answered that it was decided to finance international projects in our state through the treasury of the Republic of Uzbekistan. Since then, the International Commission for Projects has not contacted us.”

Further, Khabibullo Nosirov informed that SPACECOM project management in Uzbekistan approved syllabuses of master classes, which were sent and will be held during a visit to Uzbekistan by foreign colleagues. Regarding master classes from our side, soon syllabuses will be sent to foreign colleagues for discussion.

He also announced plans to hold a meeting on SPACECOM in the city of Fergana on December 9-10, 2021 and informed about the conference “Actual problems of space technologies and satellite communications”, which was held in Tashkent on November 23-24, 2021. As part of the report on this in Marisol's letter, there will be an opportunity to find out the evaluation of the financial and technical reports of SPACECOM project.

Dmitriy Galayka, a representative of the University in Sorbonne, suggested that it would be more difficult to get into Germany than in France in the near future, so he proposed to unite these "schools" at the Sorbonne on April 11-15 and organize master classes not only with teachers from the Sorbonne, but also with project participants from other countries. If it is

necessary to resolve issues with visas for the SPACECOM project participants, the Sorbonne University can arrange a letter to the French Embassy in Uzbekistan. To do this, we need to provide a list of invitees within the budget, who need visas.

Tentatively, the visit of foreign representatives of the SPACECOM project to Uzbekistan is scheduled for March 21, 2022, and a visit to Sofia for June 27-July 1, 2022.

RESOLUTION:

1. Write a letter from the coordinator of the SPACECOM project in Uzbekistan to Marisol with a question about the status of the reports.
2. Send syllabuses of master classes to foreign participants of the SPACECOM project for consideration and post them on the site.
3. Find out at the French Embassy in Uzbekistan whether visas are provided to participants of international projects for the entire period of the project.
4. The next project meeting will be held on the second Tuesday of January 2022.
